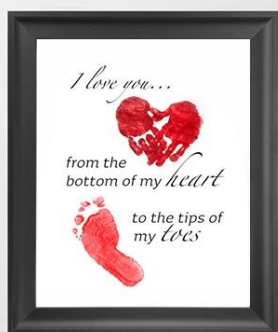


Idea of the Month

6 months: Likes to play with others, especially parents.

1 year: Plays games such as "peek-a-boo."

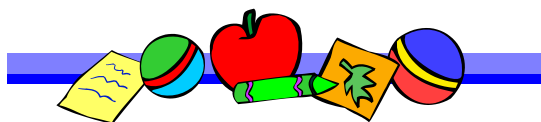
2 years: Plays next to other children. Begins to include others in games, such as "chase."

5 years: Wants to please friends. Imitates friends.
